



Elevation profile

The 10 mile/16Km 'Middy' Ride takes us from the

centre of Debenham out to Wetheringsett and to the fantastic Mid Suffolk Light Railway before looping back around to our starting point in Debenham.

This ride has taken it's name from one of the points-of-interest that it passes as it winds it's way along the country roads between Debenham and Wetheringsett. The Mid-Suffolk Light Railway (MSLR), a hidden historical gem in the very heart of Suffolk, is affectionately known as MIddy by many of it's volunteers and the locals in the area.

The quiet country roads in the area make for a delightful ride, with only the occassional vehicle to disturb the tranquility of the countryside. As with much of Suffolk, there's a lot of history hidden among the slightly undulating countryside and it's worth keeping your eyes open to see some of this hidden beauty.

Point of arrival

Debenham Village Green, Debenham, Suffolk, IP14 6QA Turn-by-turn directions

- From the Debenham Village Green, turn right onto the High Street and take the first left onto Chancery Lane in abotu 50 meters.
- Stay on Chancery Lane as it turns to the right and follow it to the end in about 300 meters.
- Go straight over the crossroads onto Little London Hill where we join the Heart of Suffolk Cycle Route (National Cycle Network 40)
- Follow Little London Hill for about 1KM and then turn left onto the un-named road.
- Continue along the un-named road for about 900M before taking a sharp left to stay on the

same road.

- Stay on the road for about 1.5Km until you arrive at a Y-Junction in the tiny hamlet of Broad Green.
- Turn right at the Y-junction and follow for abotu 600M, before turning right at White Horse Corner onto Pages Green.
- After 1.2 KM, keep right onto High Lane and follow the road for 1.9Km to turn left onto Dale Hill.
- At the end of Dale Hill, turn left onto Church Street and you will find All Saints Church on the left after about 300M
- After All Saints Church, keep left at the next junction (100M) to head onto Hockey Hill.
- Stay on Hockey Hill for about 900M and then turn left onto Hall Lane to arrive at the Mid-Suffolk Light Railway.
- From the MSLR, turn left onto Station Road and head straight for 2.3Km before turning left onto the un-named road opposite a bus stop.
- Stay on the un-named road for 900M before turning right at Broad Green onto another unnamed road - following this to the end.
- At the end of the un-named road, turn right (another un-named road) and follow to the end before turning right onto Little London Hill.
- Follow Little London Hill for about 900M until you arrive at the crossroads and then head straight over back onto Chancery Lane.
- Stay on Chancery Lane until you pass the Debenham United Reformed Church and then turn left to arrive at Aspall Road.
- Turn right onto Aspall Road to climb up the shallow hill and arrive back at the Debenham Village Green.
